

The Red line on the map above shows the route of a large cable which would link the proposed Roundhill Solar Farm at Stock Green to the National Grid Switching Station at Astwood Lane. What is proposed?

- JBM Solar have made a planning application to construct a 49.9 megawatt solar farm and 22 battery storage units on land at Earls Common Road, Stock Green.
- In order to feed the electricity generated into the National Grid it is proposed to connect the site to the switching station just outside Feckenham village using a large underground cable.

Why is this concerning for Feckenham?

- The cable would be installed by digging a trench 1.6 metres deep and approximately 700mm wide.
- There would be a 10 metre wide construction zone needed along the route.
- The route passes close to the Wylde Moor Nature Reserve (SSSI) and listed buildings. There is also potential for damage to archaeological and heritage sites.
- Heavy construction traffic would need to use Moors Lane to access the site.
- Rockhill Lane and the B4090 would also be impacted by the work.

What is the Parish Council's view?

Feckenham Parish Council agreed at a meeting on 5th April to lodge an objection to the proposal in general and to the cable route in particular. The text of this objection will be available on the Wychavon District Council planning website and at feckenham-parishcouncil.gov.uk
