5. BOROUGH COUNCILLORS REPORT. Cllr Clayton updated the parish council on the changes at Redditch Borough Council as no one party had overall control at the recent elections. However, the conservatives, Reform and two independent councillors would take control. Technically labour and reform are in opposition. Similar results throughout the country. At Worcestershire County Council, conservatives formed coalitions with other parties including green A green councillor was elected leader of the council unless Reform vote him out.

The PC requested Cllr Clayton ask WCC Highways to attend the parish and pump out the drains from Dunstill court to Swansbrook Lane The parish feel this work needs doing more frequently as it would help with flooding. If necessary, the parish would consider funding extra visits dependent upon costs. Cllr Clayton agreed to speak with Highways.

There is only 18 months until Unitary councils are established so there are unlikely to be elections next year. A decision on whether there is one or two unitary councils.
